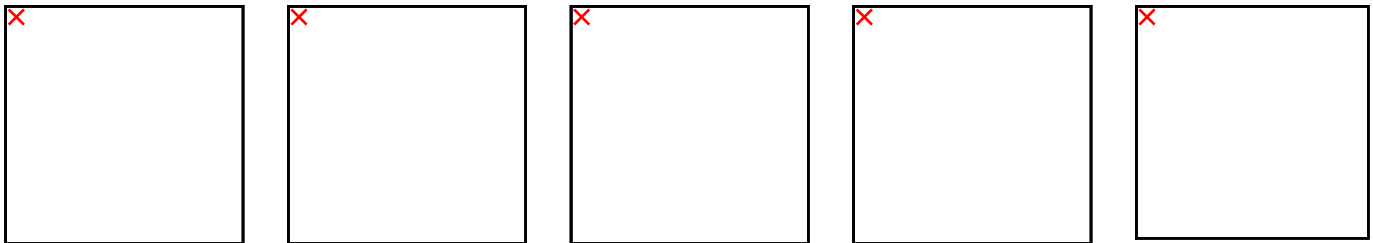

About Kelso and Scottish Borders

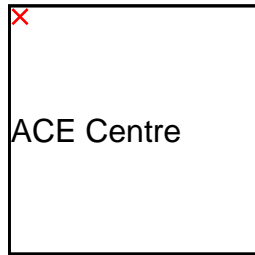

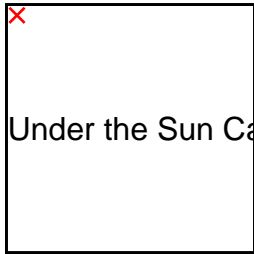

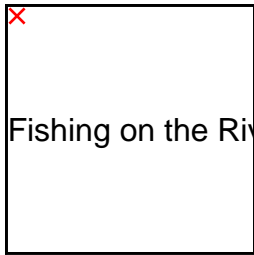

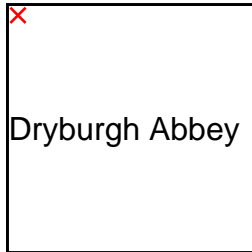

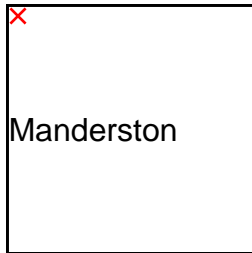

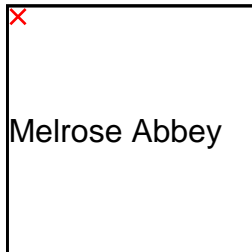

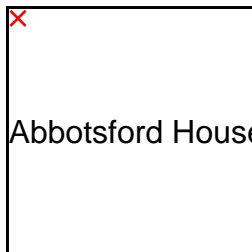

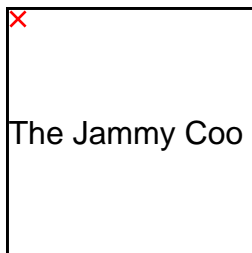

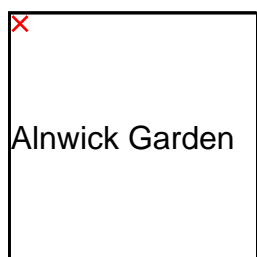

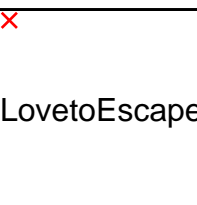
