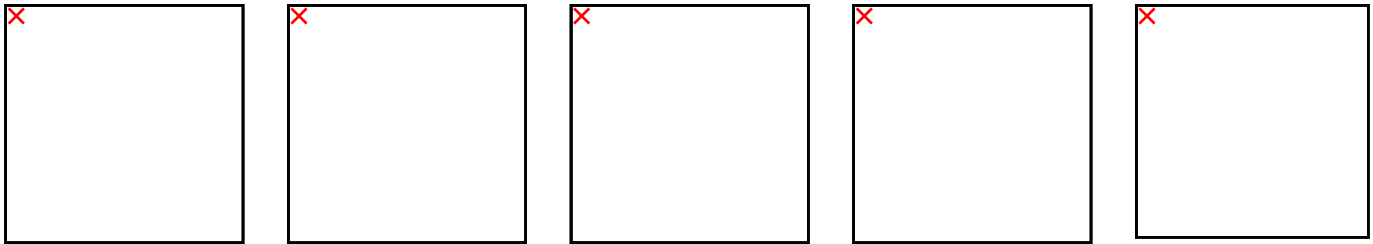

Nearest Motorway: Junction 16 M56

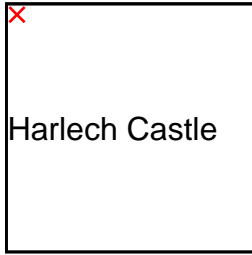

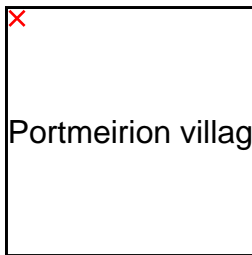


Pinnacle of Medieval castle building

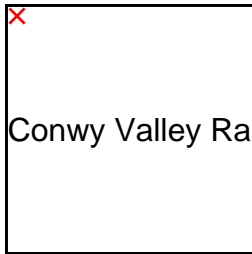

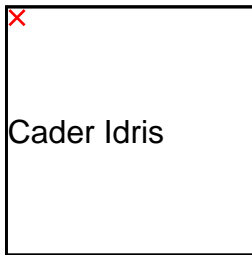

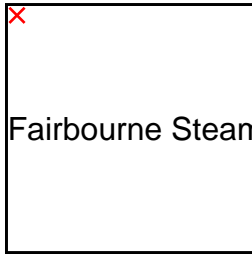


Mountain in Snowdonia, North Wales, one of the most popular mountains in Wales

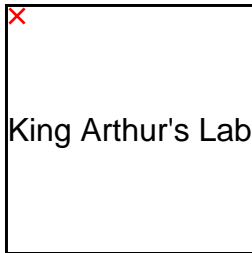


Beautiful steam railway and Nature Reserver in mid Wales

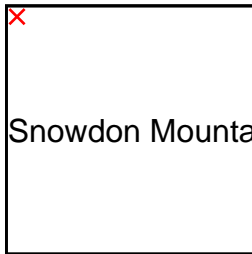

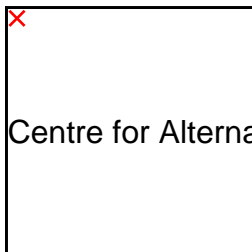

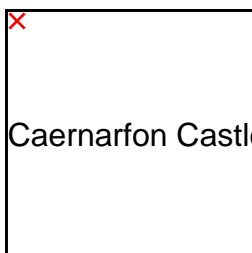

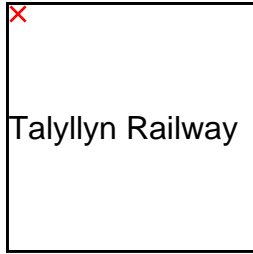

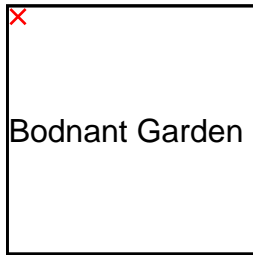

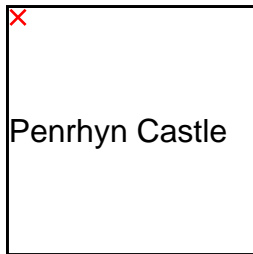

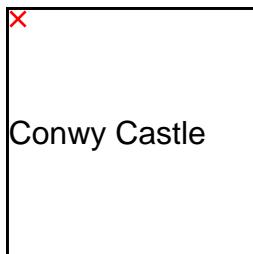
