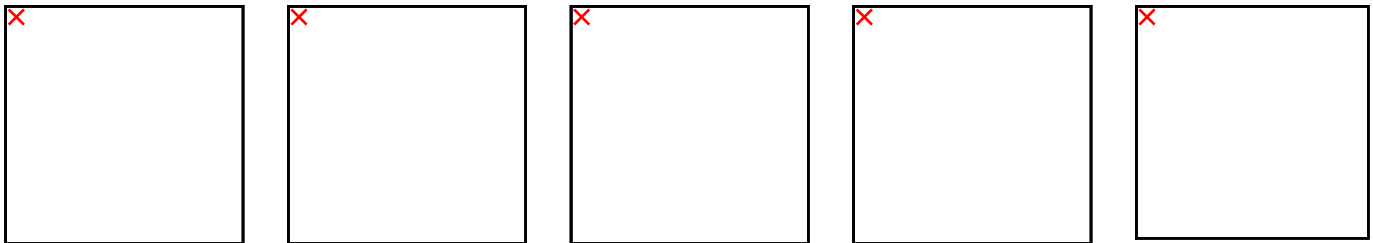

Nearest Train Station: Pontypool, 7 miles

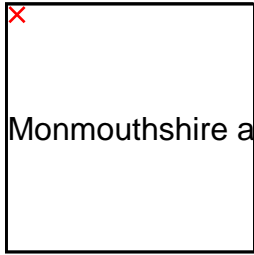

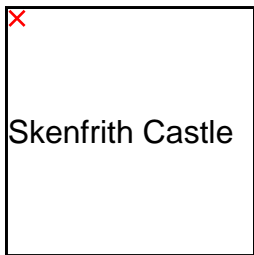

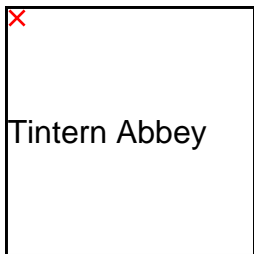


Remains of an early 13th-century fortress

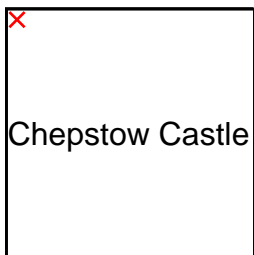


The ruins of Tintern Abbey

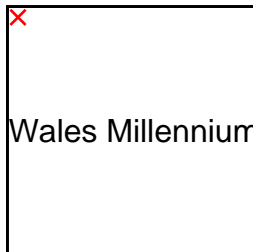


A castle located in Chepstow, Monmouthshire in Wales, on top of cliffs overlooking the River Wye

Visitor Centres and Museums, Live Entertainment

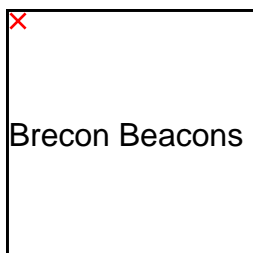


The Wales Millennium Centre opened in 2004, it has gained a great reputaion within performing arts and as an iconic arts and cultural destination.

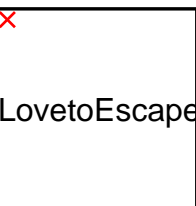
