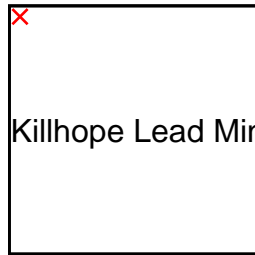

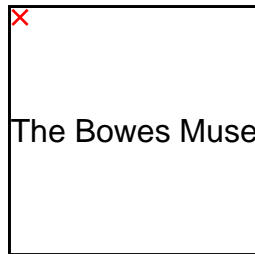


The North of Engalnd Lead Mining Museum lies high up in the North Pennines

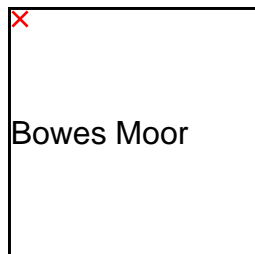

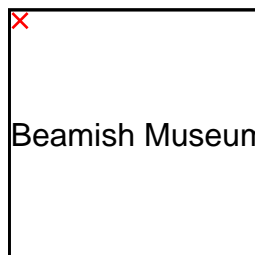


Dramatic landscape between County Durham and Cumbria
