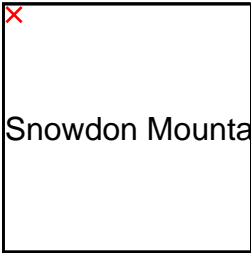
About Llanrug and Gwynedd

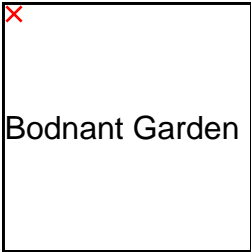

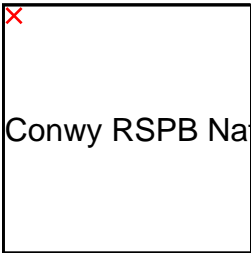

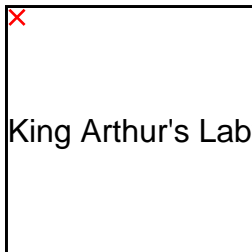
