

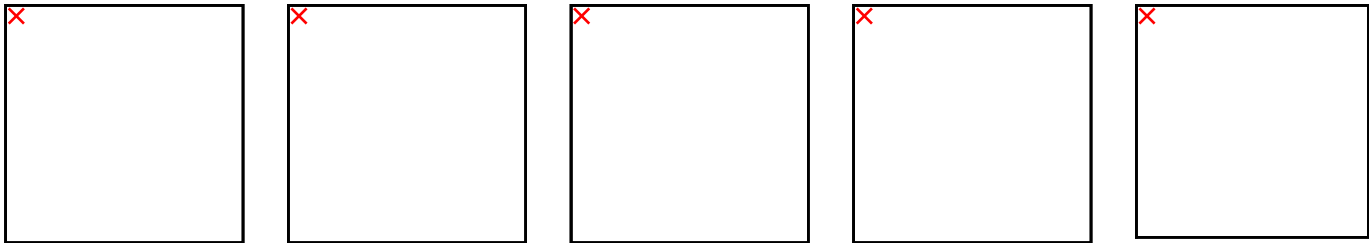

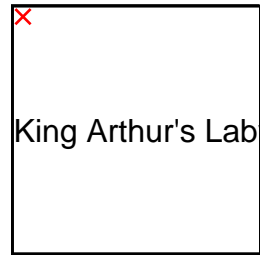
About Aberdovey and Gwynedd

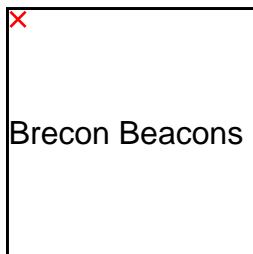
