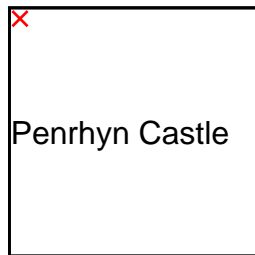
About Llanberis and Gwynedd
