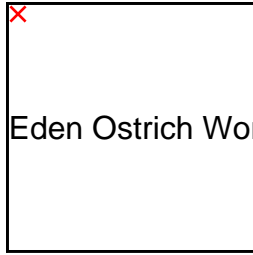
About Middleton-In-Teesdale and County Durham

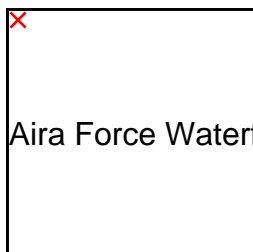

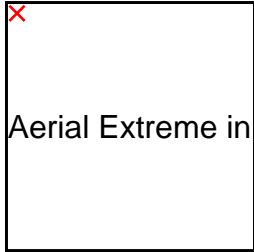


National Trust run waterfall on the western side of Ullswater in the Lake District. Superb walk to the waterfall in an enchanted woodland. Toilets and café on site.

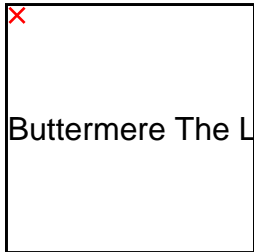
