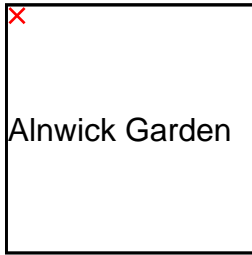
About Embleton and Northumberland

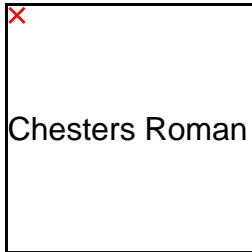

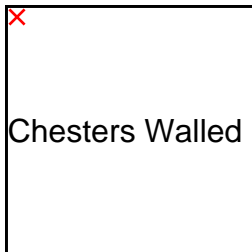


Remains of a fort built to guard the Roman bridge over the River Tyne

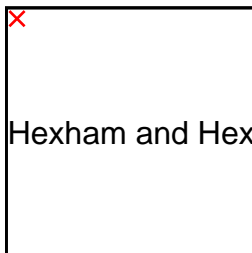

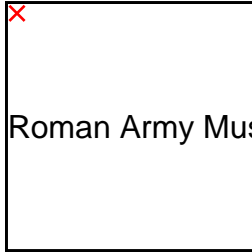
