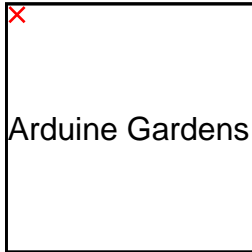

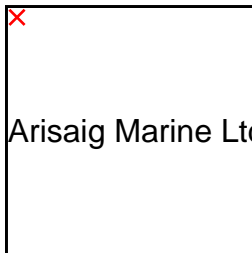


This wonderful garden forms a horticultural tour around the world with a collection of Blue Tibetan poppies and Chatham Island forget-me-nots.
