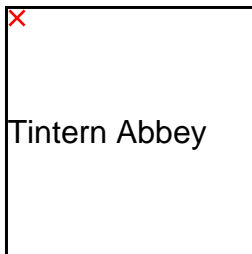

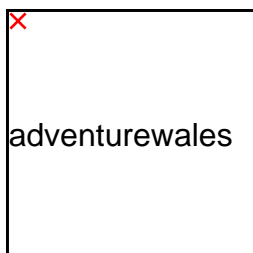

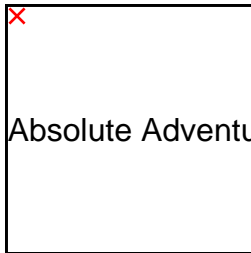

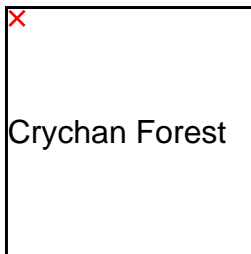

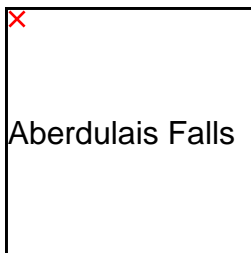

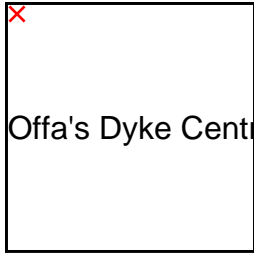

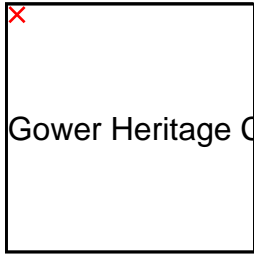


Showing the history of Offa's Dyke and the route of the long distance path
